

Six methods as an alternative to written correction

MÉTODOS

1 VERBAL FEEDBACK
Read pupils' work, fill one worksheet per class with relevant data and later share this information with pupils.

2 MODELLING
Provide feedback and guidance before writing or doing an assignment. Use the "I-we-you" approach.

3 LIVE FEEDBACK
Show/Project a learner's work in class to review it and identify positive elements and areas for improvement.

4 INDIVIDUAL FEEDBACK
Observe individual work, recommending an improvement or pointing out a mistake.

5 QUESTION FEEDBACK
Check the understanding of activities through self-graded tasks to improve their recall of the correct answer in the future.

6 SELF-ASSESSMENT
Use criteria and/or keyword checklists to understand the assessment criteria.
